HOTCHKISS' Geological Map OF Virginia AND West Virginia.

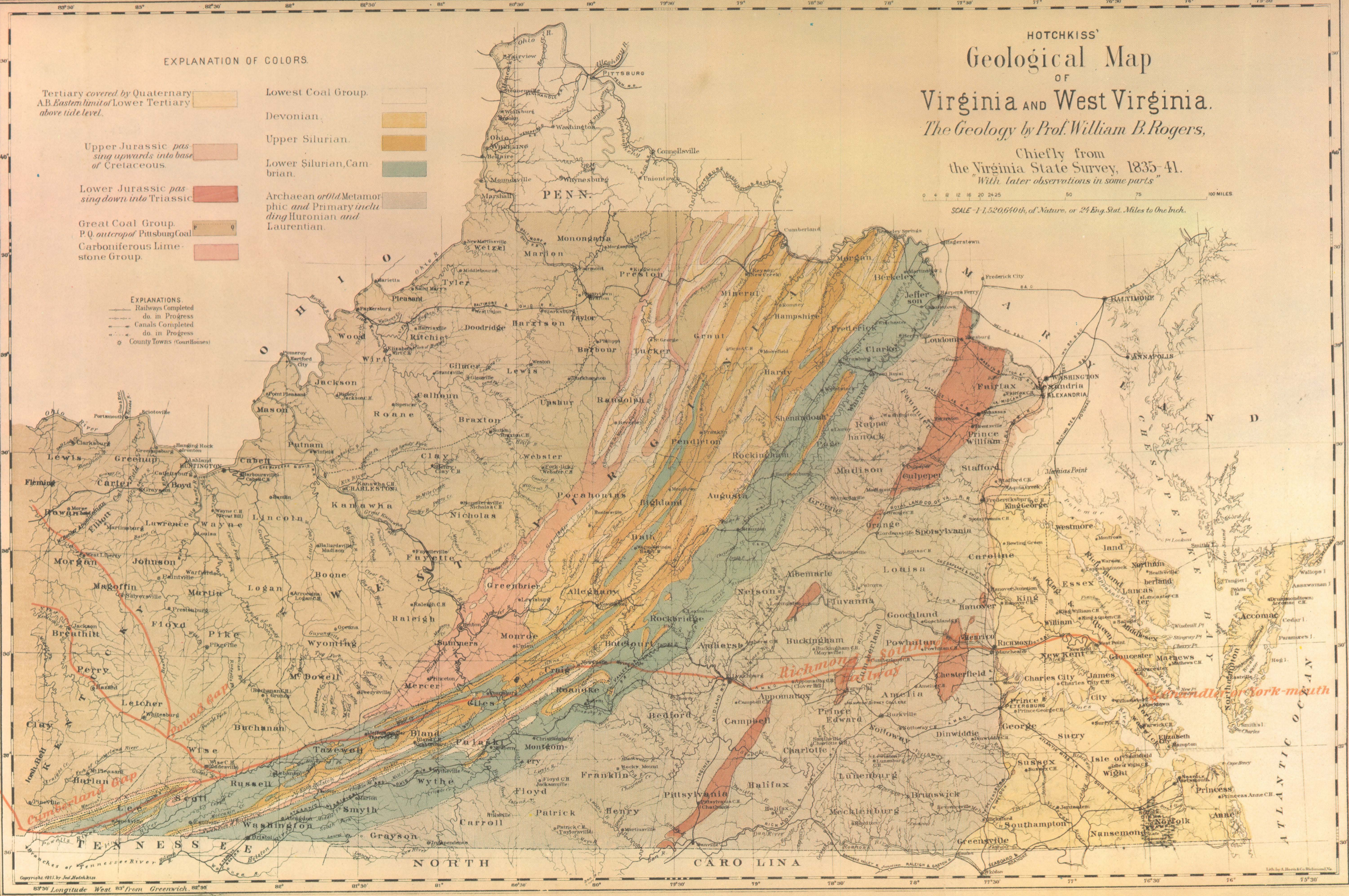
The Geology by Prof. William B. Rogers, Chiefly from the Virginia State Survey, 1835-41. With later observations in some parts.
