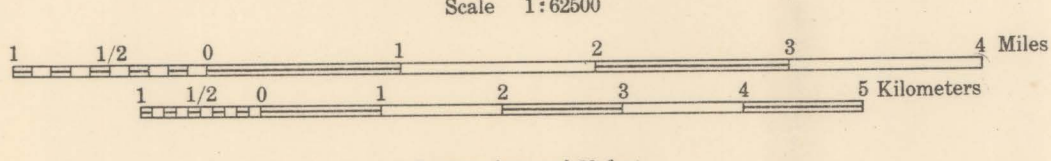




MAP
